

## Douglas County School System COVID-19 Weekly 7-day Case Report

## October 15, 2021 – October 21, 2021

This report summarizes COVID-19 cases and the percent of positive COVID-19 cases per school location from Friday to Thursday among students and staff. A case is defined as a person with a positive COVID test. Cases are summed across staff and students enrolled and/or working at the school location. The percent of cases per school (location) represents the number of cases within the school divided by the school's total student and staff population. Student cases at the College and Career Institute (CCI) are reported at the student's base school. An asterisk (\*) indicates that there are too few cases in the population to report.
