Goal 1: The Superintendent will work with staff to demonstrate academic growth as measured through student growth percentiles resulting from implementing state standards with fidelity

- Elementary: Increase the percentage of proficient and above performance from 32% to 36% in 3rd-5th Math End of Grade Assessment by 6 percentage points (4%) of the potential growth.
- Middle: Increase the percentage of proficient and above performance from 24% to 29% in 6th-8th Math End of Grade Assessment by 6 percentage points (4.6%) of the potential growth.
- High: Increase the percentage of proficient and above performance from 20% to 25% in High School Mathematics End of Course Assessment by 6 percentage points (4.8%) of the potential growth.
